KEY MESSAGES




New survey findings reveal that workers who regularly work remotely using information and communication technologies are more likely to work longer than is contractually required. Close to one fifth of the survey respondents reported working additional hours because they are contacted outside of working hours.

Eight out of ten workers reported that they regularly receive work-related communications outside their working hours.

A match between working time and workload is crucial. The new survey findings demonstrate that 37% of workers work additional hours to complete tasks they were unable to do during working hours.
