Cantina d'Isera

Since 1907 the Cantina d'Isera is a cooperative of Trentino grape growers and is noted for several exceptional interpretations of the traditional Marzemino wines that you will only find in Trentino.

Next we will visit the Cantina Grigoli in Mori. Since 1800, the Grigoli family has passed down the farming tradition and viticulture by raising cattle with the production of cheese and butter, cultivating wheat and tobacco and initially producing wine for family use only. The oenologist Bruno Grigoli and his son Marco will share their story through their wines, enhancing the territory in which they live, the classic vines, the climate and the winemaking practices transmitted with great passion from generation to generation.

Madonna delle Vittorie in Linfano near Arco is now part of the Marzadro family and produces red and white wines Trentino DOC in the classic and summolaco (blend of grapes) lines, as well as sparkling wines. The oil mill Madonna delle Vittorie presses only Garda Trentino olives and extracts superior quality extra virgin olive oil.



Cantina Pisoni



Here we will try the unique Trentino vino santo at the **Cantina Pisoni** in Pergolese in the Valle dei Laghi. This winery has been innovative in developing the Revo similar to the Amarone style of appassimento. In addition you can purchase part of Trentino with the purchase of a vine with your plaque. In addition they also produce some extra virgin olive oil. Cousins and strong enthusiasts in the world of wine, Marco and Stefano have dedicated their time to cultivating the land with love, respect,
